It's a Dog!

How many times have you heard an enthusiastic dog owner exclaim, "He thinks he's a person"? I don't know how that statement makes you feel, but personally, I feel like bursting out in laughter every time someone says it.

Dogs, no matter what breed they are or how they have been raised, simply do not think they are human. In fact, dogs don't even *think* they are dogs. Dogs and other animals do NOT think about such things, ever, at all, period.

Even the great apes, which seem to be *almost* human, do not sit around and ponder their existence or philosophize about their 'ape-ness'. Animals, including your beloved pet poodle, are guided by instincts. The way certain dogs act or react in specific situations may be determined to some extent by what particular breed it is, or the environment it was raised in, but the underlying factor is still instinct.

For example, it is natural for any dog to bark when a stranger comes to the door. It is signaling a warning, both to the stranger and to the 'family'— the pack. That doesn't mean it is speaking like a human. It's just instinct.

So the next time you are tempted to make such statements about your pampered pet, remember there is nothing wrong with letting your dog be just a dog.
